

Anything posted from this account no longer reflects the values or teachings of the Catholic Church, St. Brigid Parish, or the Diocese of Fresno.

On Monday, July 15, we celebrate the Memorial of Saint Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church. St. Bonaventure was known as the "seraphic doctor". He was good friends with St. Thomas Aquinas and at age 22, entered the Franciscan order. By 35, he was General of the Order and as General, composed The Life of St. Francis. He was an Italian medieval scholastic theologian, philosopher, and Cardinal and Bishop of Albano.

Similar to St. Francis, St. Bonaventure had a deep devotion to the Eucharist and truly believed that Jesus was present under the appearances of bread and wine. This led him to compose this beautiful prayer that expresses the passionate love he had for Jesus.

Many use this prayer after communion, as it speaks directly to Jesus, the "Bread of Angels."

Pierce. O most sweet Lord Jesus. my inmost soul with the most ioyous and healthful wound of Thy love, and with true, calm and most holy apostolic charity, that my soul may ever languish and melt with entire love and longing for Thee, may yearn for Thee and for thy courts. may long to be dissolved and to be with Thee. Grant that my soul may hunger after Thee. the Bread of Angels, the refreshment of holy souls, our daily and supersubstantial bread. having all sweetness and savor and every delightful taste. May my heart ever hunger after and feed upon Thee. Whom the angels desire to look upon, and may my inmost soul be filled with the sweetness of Thy savor: may it ever thirst for Thee, the fountain of life, the fountain of wisdom and knowledge. the fountain of eternal light, the torrent of pleasure. the fulness of the house of God: may it ever compass Thee. seek Thee, find Thee, run to Thee, come up to Thee, meditate on Thee, speak of Thee. and do all for the praise and glory of Thy name, with humility and discretion, with love and delight, with ease and affection, with perseverance to the end; and be Thou alone ever my hope. my entire confidence, my riches, my delight, my pleasure, my joy, my rest and tranquility. my peace, my sweetness, my food, my refreshment, my refuge, my help, my wisdom,

St. Brigid Church is going to begin using the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Method for our Faith Formation.

CGS is a common religious experience involving children and adults in which the religious values of childhood, primarily those values of contemplation and enjoyment of God, are predominant. This experience is shared in a place particularly prepared for the religious life of children called the Atrium.

Montessorian Gianna Gobbi, co-founder of this work, reminds us that the atrium environment and the materials on the shelves speak to the children about God without using any words. The materials allow the adult to limit their own interaction with the children, as not to interrupt the child. When the child is allowed to work and is not interrupted, the materials offer the child the time and space to think deeply about what has been proclaimed in the atrium, without the constant interference of the adult. How wonderful for the child, that he or she can enter this experience with God without needing the adult to have to say or to speak words every time.

JOIN IN THE WONDER OF THE 3-6-YEAR-OLD CHILD

The 3-6-year-old child is particularly capable of receiving and enjoying the most essential elements of our faith—the announcement of God's love especially experienced through Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who died and is risen. Materials on the life of Jesus Christ and his teachings help to make the mystery of God concrete for the child. The heart of the catechesis for children under six revolves around the Parable of the Good Shepherd. Jesus announces that he is the Good Shepherd who calls each one by name. The sheep listen to the voice of the Shepherd and follow him.

The 3–6-year-old child enters the mystery of the Eucharist by first learning the names of the articles used on the altar and then through the most important gestures including the preparation of the chalice, the epiclesis and offering, and the sign of peace. Through the experience of seeing these gestures, presented one by one, the Mass emerges as the Sacrament of the Gift. The child becomes acquainted with the historical character of the liturgy through the events of the Last Supper, Christ's death, and His resurrection.




